

Materials

- *Can You Guess?* BLM 2
- 11" x 17" construction paper
- magazines (for pictures)
- scissors, crayons, glue

Directions

1. Have children cut out a picture of a familiar plant or animal from a magazine or have them draw a picture.
2. Fold the construction paper in half to make a book.
3. Cut a hole in the center of the book cover.
4. Glue the picture or drawing under the hole inside the book. Write the name of the plant or animal underneath the picture.
5. Write a clue on the book cover (for example, *I have a beak. I eat insects. I am green.*).
6. Children share their books and guess the plant or animal behind the circle.

Language Activity

Children read a clue aloud and then identify a familiar plant or animal from seeing only a small part of it. They check their answer by looking at a picture and reading a label.
