

Materials

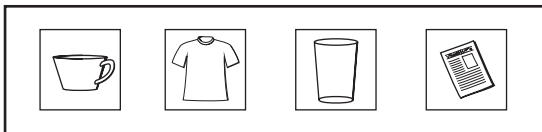
- 20" x 5" construction paper
- 17" x 5" construction paper
- 17" x 4" construction paper
- old magazines
- scissors, glue, stapler, crayons

Directions

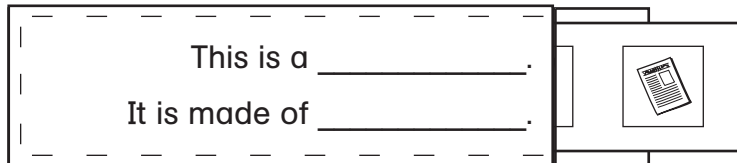
1. Place the 17" x 5" piece of paper on top of the 20" x 5" piece of paper. Staple the pieces together on three sides to create a sleeve.



2. Draw objects or cut out pictures of objects from magazines and glue onto one side of the 17" x 4" construction paper at regular intervals.



3. Slide the 17" x 4" construction paper face-up into the sleeve.
4. Write the pattern sentences on the front of the sleeve, as shown below.



Language Activity

Children pull out the picture tab from the sleeve, revealing one object at a time. Then they read the pattern sentences and fill in the blanks. Children can share their pull-tab books.
