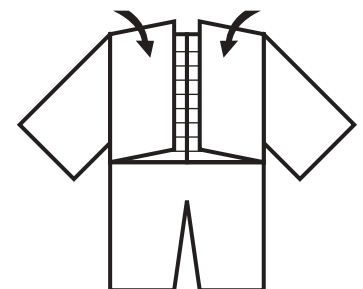
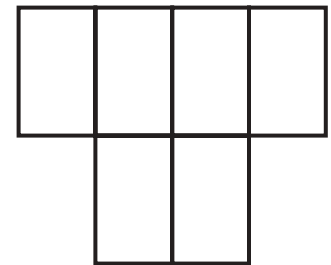
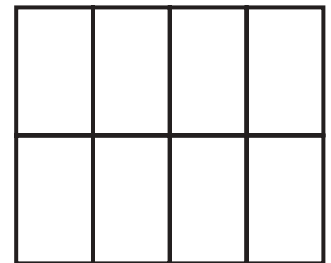


Materials

- 18" x 24" construction paper, various colors
- 12" x 18" white paper
- construction paper scraps
- scissors, glue, crayons, stapler
- 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" writing paper

Directions

1. Fold the piece of 18" x 24" construction paper into 8 equal parts as shown.
2. Cut out the 2 bottom corner pieces and keep them to use as arms.
3. Fold the top 2 corner pieces inward to make a jacket. Glue on the 2 bottom corner pieces to make arms as shown.
4. Cut a small triangle from the bottom section as shown to make pants.
5. Use the extra construction paper to draw a head and to make hands and shoes. Glue them to the Person Book.
6. Staple writing paper inside the jacket.
