

### Materials

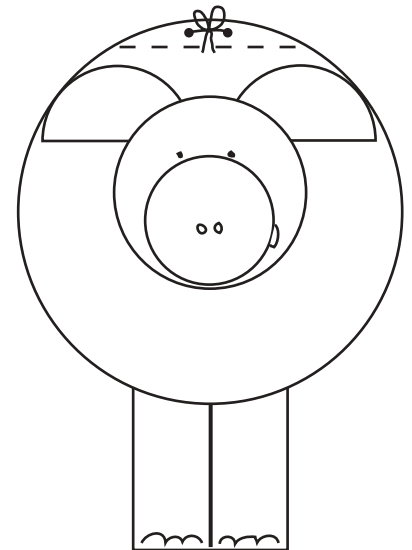
- *The Three Little Pigs Go into Town* BLM 2 and BLM 3
- 2 pieces of 9" x 9" pink tagboard
- 1 piece of 9" x 9" pink construction paper
- 2 pieces of lined writing paper
- string or ribbon
- scissors, glue, crayons, hole puncher

### Directions

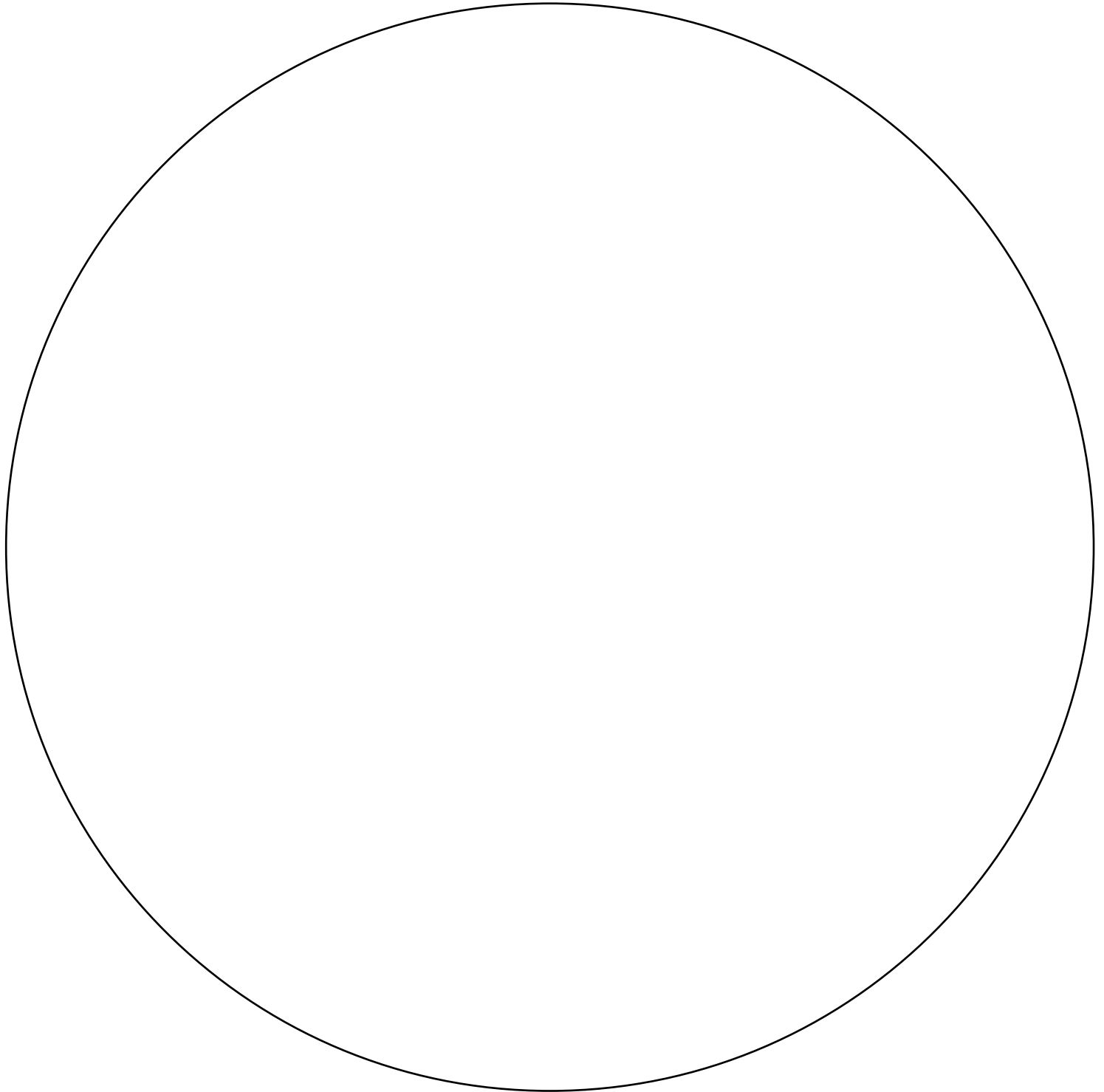
1. Cut out the circle on BLM 2 and use it to make a circle on both pieces of 9" x 9" pink poster board. Cut out to make front and back covers.
2. Trace the circle onto both pieces of writing paper and cut out the circles. Staple them to back cover.
3. Cut out the shapes on BLM 3. Trace on the pink construction paper and then cut out the features.
4. Glue face, nose, and ears to front cover. Add details (eyes, nostrils, tongue) with crayons.
5. Glue legs to back cover.
6. Place front cover over the writing paper. Punch two holes at top and tie with ribbon or string.

### Language Activity

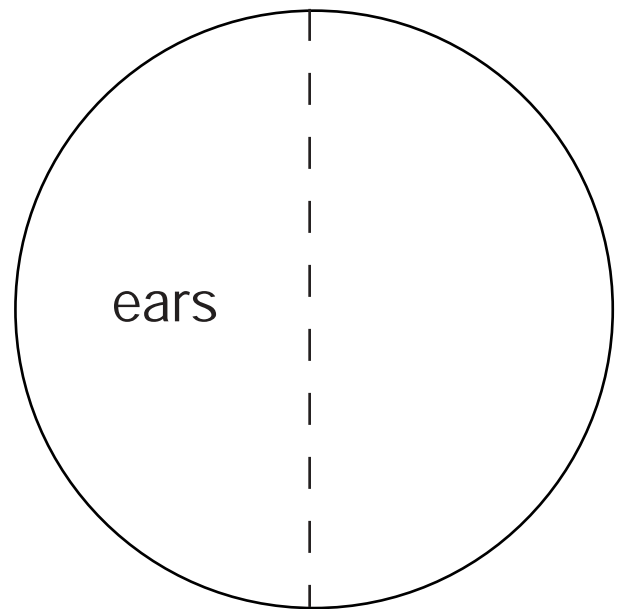
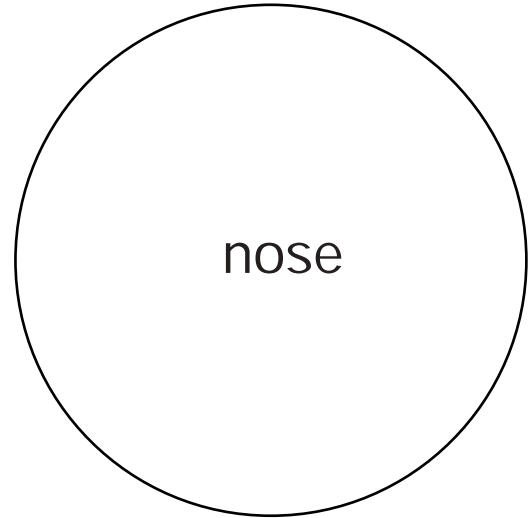
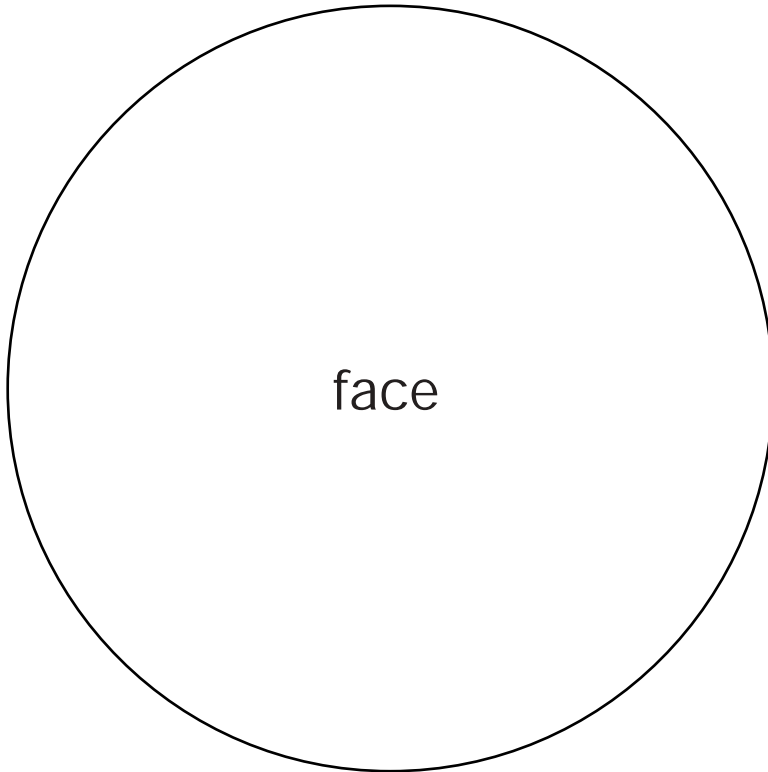
Children write about how something (such as bicycles, people, wagons, etc.) can be slowed down. On the second sheet of writing paper, they tell how it can be helped to go faster.
