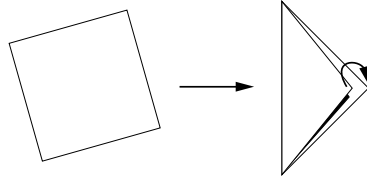


Materials

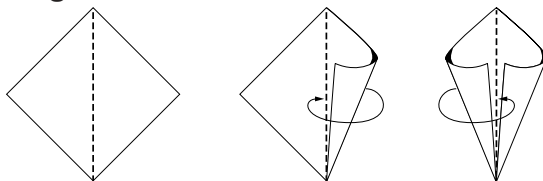
- 12" x 12" square construction paper, various colors
- scissors, stapler, glue
- scrap paper, various colors
- writing paper

Directions

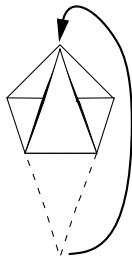
1. Fold the square paper corner to corner.



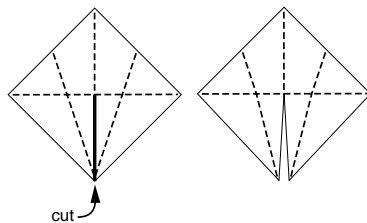
2. Unfold the paper; then fold the edges toward the middle.



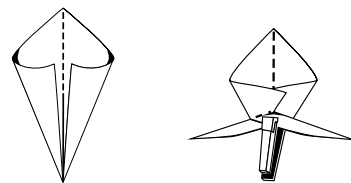
3. Fold the narrow point to the top.



4. Open the paper. Cut up the center line, stopping at the middle.

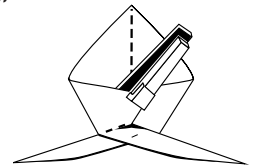


5. Refold the paper. Cross the "legs" and staple them together.

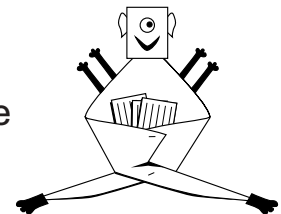


6. Staple the "pocket."

7. Add scrap paper features: eyes, nose, ears, antennae, and so on.



8. Place writing paper in the pocket.



Language Activity

Children write about simple machines found in the book, in the classroom, and at home. "Feed" the writing paper to the space creature by placing it in its pocket.
