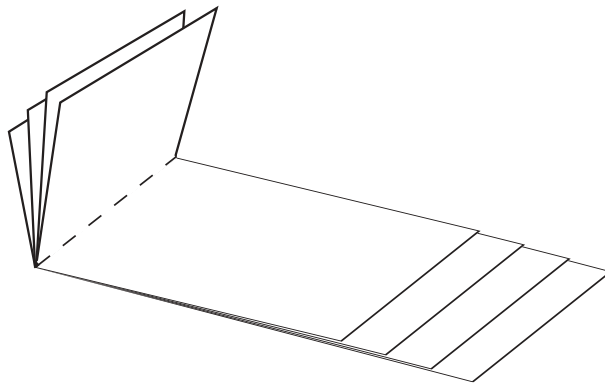
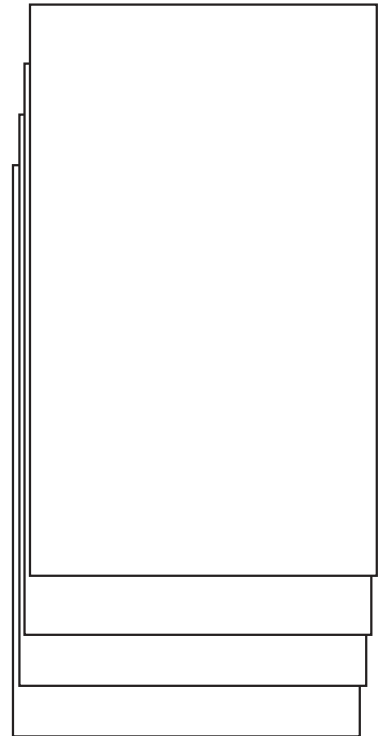


Materials

- 8½" x 11" white paper
- stapler, crayons

Directions

1. Overlap four pieces of paper, leaving a margin of about 1½" at the bottom of each page.
2. Carefully fold over the pages as shown, leaving another 1½" margin between the folded section and the bottom section.
3. Staple through the top of all eight pages.
4. Write the title on the top page of the book and illustrate the cover.



Language Activity

Starting at the top of the book, students label the seven stages of human growth and change, one stage per page, as shown: Baby, Toddler, Preschooler, Older child, Teenager, Adult, and Senior. Students then write a sentence about each stage on the top of each step; then they illustrate the page.
