

Materials

- two paper plates
- plastic wrap
- scissors, stapler, crayons
- writing paper cut into $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces

Directions

1. Draw and color a scene from pioneer life on the inside of a paper plate. Cut a piece of plastic wrap and cover the picture, stapling it to the edge of the plate.
2. Cut out the flat, circular part of the second paper plate, leaving the outer edge intact.
3. Staple the outer edge of the second plate, bottom side up, to the first plate, over the picture and plastic wrap to form a frame.
4. Staple or glue the writing paper to the bottom of the picture frame. The frames can be displayed on a bulletin board or hung up with string.

Language Activity

Students illustrate a pioneer scene and write about the illustration.
