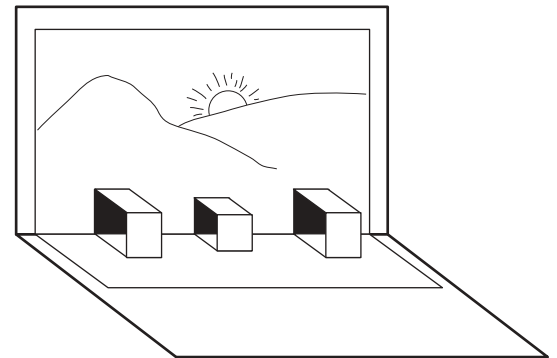


**Materials**

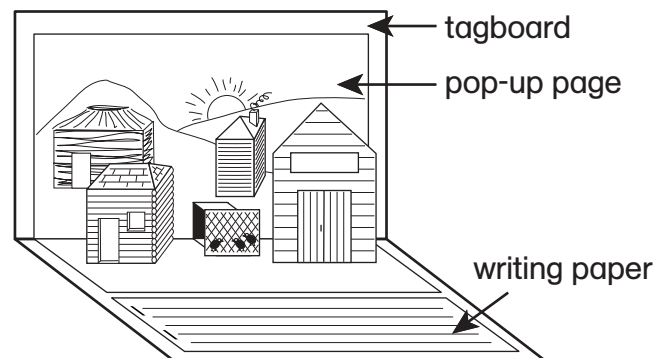
- *Time-Travel Tuesdays: Pioneer Community* BLM 2
- 8½" x 11" white paper
- 10" x 16" tagboard, various colors
- 4" x 9" writing paper
- scissors, glue, stapler, crayons


**Directions**

1. On BLM 2, cut off the top of the page.
2. Cut along the dotted lines and fold on the solid line that connects the 3 tabs. Refold, pushing the pop-up tabs to the inside of the fold.
3. Fold tagboard in half. Glue pop-up page carefully inside the tagboard as shown, making sure that the fold line of the white paper matches up with the fold line of the tagboard. Do not glue the pop-up tabs. Draw a background for the scene on the top half of the white paper.
3. Draw five or six buildings from a pioneer community on drawing paper. Cut out the buildings and glue them onto the pop-up tabs and the background.
4. Staple the writing paper to the tagboard underneath the pioneer scene.
5. Write the title on the front of the book and illustrate the cover.

**Language Activity**

Students number the buildings in their pioneer community and write corresponding sentences to describe them.
